5 tips on to GET FISCALLY FIT

Kick start your year with healthy financial habits you can keep.



1

Slim down the extra expenses

Are you paying extra fees or for subscriptions you aren't using? Cut them out of your expenses, and instead use that amount as an automatic deposit to your savings.

2

Write down your goals

Jot down your goals and put them up somewhere you will see them often like the bathroom mirror. Print off pictures that are associated with the goal to make it feel more tangible.

3

Train your fiscal muscles

Attend a workshop at the credit union or take a course online. Meet with a credit union representative to go over your goals and get help finding ways to achieve them.

4

Quit bad habits and start a better one

The first of the year is a great time to quit a bad habit like vending machine candy bars, cigarettes or fancy coffee drinks. Instead take the money used for that daily habit and put it in a separate savings account for a goal that's important to you. Pick a goal that has an shorter pay off like a summer vacation to help quit the bad habit.

Put yourself first

Automatically deposit a portion of your paycheck each month into savings. Be sure the deposit goes in before you pay any bills or expenses. Avoid the urge to transfer or spend the money by opening a separate savings account.

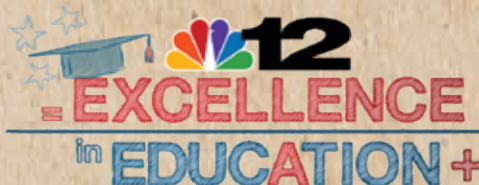

Allison Buschy has served as a member of the Henrico Federal Credit Union Board of Directors since 2010. She has also been a member of the personnel, nominating, and scholarship selection committees. Currently she is serving as the Vice Chairman for Henrico FCU.

When asked about her current motivation and how she plans to contribute to the credit union:



I am committed to ensuring the members of the credit union are served in the best way possible. This includes not only looking for new and better ways to serve our members, but also being true to the core values that have made the credit union what it is today.

Allison is currently the Assistant Director of Recreation & Parks for Henrico County. She previously worked in the Public Utilities Operations Division where she was involved with budget development, monitoring expenditures and balancing accounts.

Voting Rules & Regulations: Nominations may also be made by petition, signed by a minimum of 1% of the members of Henrico FCU (maximum 500). Nominations by petition must be submitted to the secretary of the Board of Directors by February 15, 2019. The petition must be accompanied by a statement of qualifications, biographical data and a certificate, signed by the nominee that s/he is agreeable to nomination and will serve if elected. There will be no nominations from the floor at the Annual Meeting, unless at that time there are not sufficient nominees for the open Board positions. To be eligible to vote you must be a primary member of Henrico FCU and be at least 16 years of age.
